Your first stop - the Halifax County Visitor Center at 1180 Bill Tuck Highway, South Boston, VA 24592 to get your maps, directions, brochures, and general information.

Arrive in time for lunch at **The Windmill Farm Bake Shop**, a family-owned Mennonite bakery. Dine in or carry out. The shop also offers local music, arts and crafts for sale. Or try **Café Peroni** for some Italian home cooking.

Thus fortified, head to one of our many antique shops. In downtown South Boston the must-sees include art at



Destination Gallery as well as antiques at **Enchanted Surroundings**, **3 Women, No Truck**, and **Sullivan's Antiques**, each with an amazing selection of antique furniture, perfectly accented by many one-of-a-kind folk art and deco pieces. Stop by **Common Grounds** for a delicious coffee drink pick-me-up on your way to **Toots Creek Antiques Mall** in Halifax, less than five miles away and boasting over 35 dealers and a large consignment area. Main Street Halifax you will find the charming and eclectic **Peddler's Market Exchange** and **Peddler's Market Annex**.

We suggest you mosey just a few doors down Main Street Halifax to **Molasses Grill** for a dinner of southern inspired cuisine.

Whether theatre or musical production, show at **The Prizery**, our world class arts center.
